Quick Start Guide — Testing Instructions

Thanks for helping me test CreatorKit! It's an AI tool that helps YouTube creators come up with video ideas, write scripts, design thumbnails, and optimize titles/descriptions for search. Here's how to get started — it only takes a couple of minutes.

1. Create Your Account

1. Go to www.creatorkit.org
2. Click "Get Started" or "Sign Up"
3. Sign up with your email and a password, OR click "Continue with Google" to use your Google account instead
4. You'll land straight in your Dashboard — no credit card needed

You start with 50 free credits to try everything out.

2. Find Your Way Around

On the left side of the dashboard you'll see the main menu:

- Dashboard — your home screen overview
- Ideas — get AI-generated video ideas for your niche
- Scripts — turn a video title into a full script
- Thumbnails — generate 4 thumbnail design variations
- SEO — optimize your title, tags, and description
- Shorts, Scheduler, Analytics, Coach — additional tools
- Settings — manage your account and plan

Your credit balance is always shown in the top right corner and at the bottom of the sidebar.

3. Try the Idea Generator

5. Click "Ideas" in the left menu
6. Enter your Channel Niche (e.g. "cooking", "python programming")
7. Enter your Target Audience (e.g. "beginners")
8. Pick a Tone/Style and how many ideas you want (10, 20, or 30)
9. Click "Generate Ideas"

You'll get a ranked list of video ideas with a demand score and estimated view range for each one.

4. Try the Script Writer

10. Click "Scripts" in the left menu
11. Enter a video title (or use one from your generated ideas)
12. Pick a tone and target video length
13. Click "Generate Script"

You'll get a full script broken into sections (Hook, Intro, main content, etc.) that you can copy or export as a text file.

5. Try the Thumbnail Generator

14. Click "Thumbnails" in the left menu
15. Enter your video title
16. Pick a Style (Gaming, Vlog, Educational, etc.) and a Color Mood
17. Click "Generate 4 Variations"

You'll get 4 different thumbnail layouts to choose from. Hover over one to download it or mark it as your primary choice.

6. Try the SEO Optimizer

18. Click "SEO" in the left menu
19. Paste in your draft video title
20. Click "Optimize SEO"

You'll get several improved title options ranked by predicted click-through rate, plus a description and tags.
